The following players may participate in the competition:

- Youngster F1N/M, Younger F1N/M up to the age of 14, i.e. born before 2009.
- Junior F1N/M (born 2005 and later).
- F1N Juniors (born 2005 and later).
- F1N Seniors

Each regional Aeroclub and Association registered in the Polish Aeroclub, having a valid license for 2023 (paid) may enter any number of competitors in any selected age categories.

It is planned to hold a competition included in the Polish Cup for 2023 in the class of F1N models in the individual classification.

Conditions of participation:

Competitors must have a valid FAI sports license issued by the Aeroclub of Poland (Note - the license does not apply to competitors starting in the Youth category).

Pursuant to Article 38(1) and (2) of the Sports Act, competitors are subject to compulsory accident insurance.

Payment of starting fees upon registration:

- Youth PLN 10
- Junior PLN 15
- Senior PLN 20

The competitor can submit 3 models - the models must be marked with the license number (young people who do not have a license sign the model with their initials).

Statute:

The competition will be held in accordance with the applicable regulations of the Polish Aeroclub for the F1N class.

The formula of the competition is in accordance with the General Regulations of the Flying and Space Models Competition, point 1.9.

Indoor F1N competitions (MP and PP) can be held in the following categories: Junior F1N/M, Junior F1N/M, Junior F1N and Senior F1N.

In the F1N/M class, the competitors launch the models holding the hull.

For the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place statuettes and diplomas
